## PEOPLE POWER ON PLANNING PROPOSALS

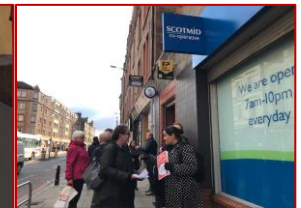
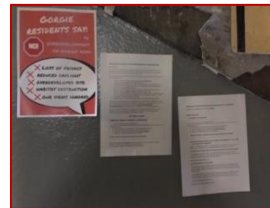
### Scotmid-Gorgie Road and Richmond Terrace
